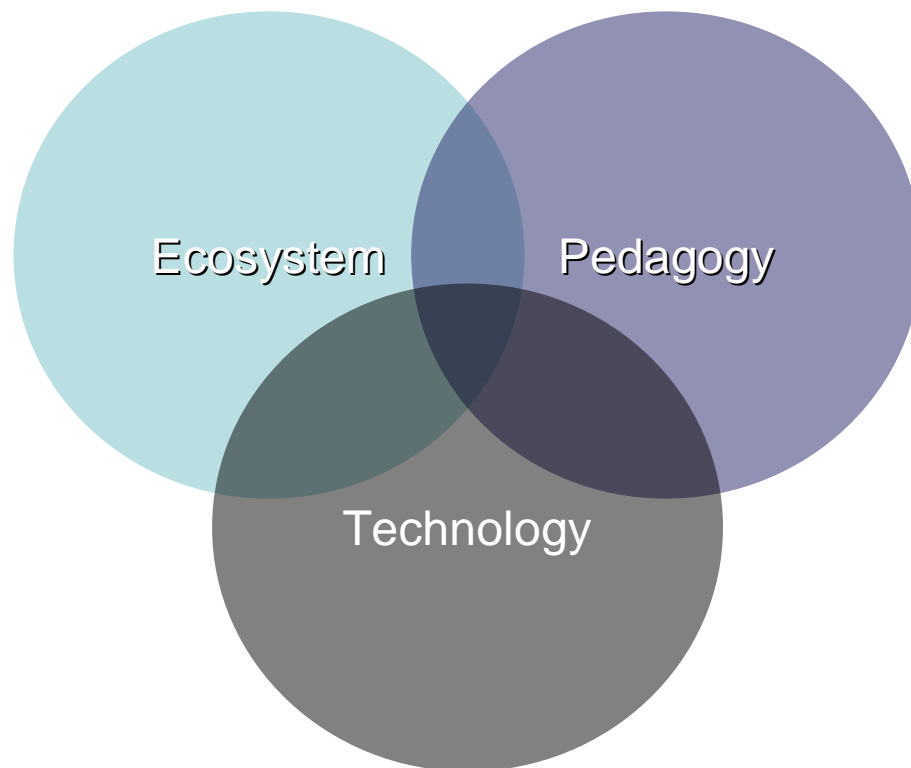


*“Innovation in education is a **sustainable improvement** that positively affects the **context**, the **processes** and the **results of learning**.”*
