

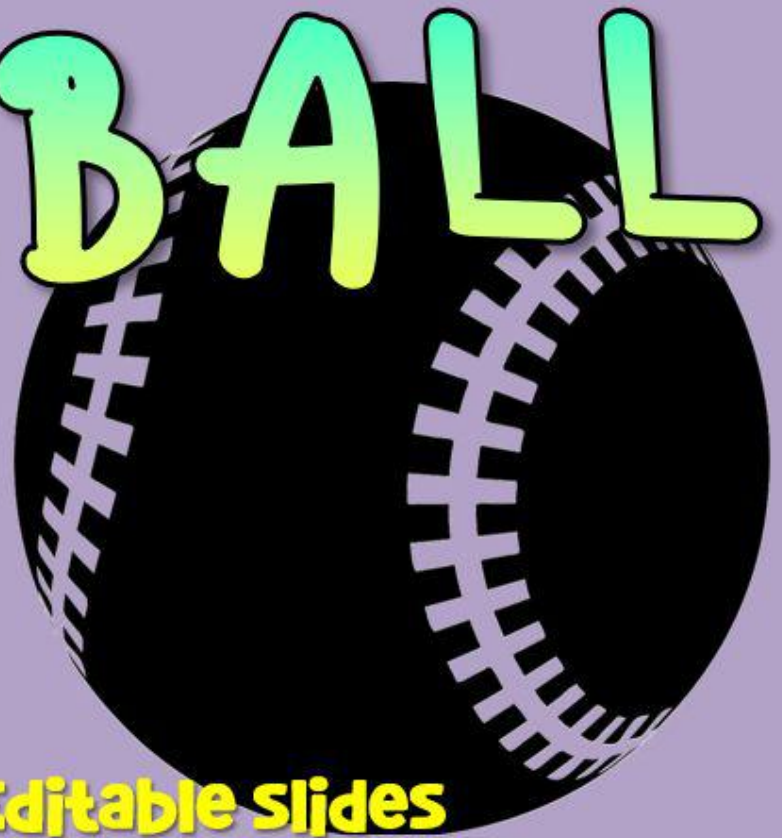

Jeopardy Team and Play Options

Team Options:

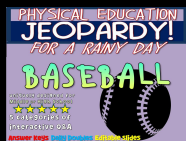
- Split the class into two sides
- Break into smaller groups of 4-5
- Each student for themselves

Play Options:

- First hand up gets to answer first (like the show) OR
- call on non-volunteers after all students or teams have some think-time, AND/OR
- encourage equal participation by requiring team members to take turns answering or playing

Other Considerations:

- Designate a scorekeeper to track points during the game
- Allow students to wager any amount that they have earned if they land on a daily double or during final jeopardy
