In PE I use them in stations, whole group instruction, no gymnasium available days and distance learning activities for home. These resources are perfect for classroom teachers as well for Super Bowl theme days, fun Fridays, language arts stations and early finishers.

### Flag Fag football it a nonphysical team sport t at k ne

obtball. Instead of tackling an opponent you steal their flag. When you steal the flag of the ball carrier that stops the play.

A flag football team has 6-10 players. All players must be wearing flag football belts with two flags near their hips. The object of the game is to steal the flag of the player with the ball.

The game looks like a real football game; the center hikes the ball to the quarterback and then the QB decides to run, handoff or pass.

The game consists of two halves that are 10-25 minutes in length based upon the ages of the players. A flag football field

is 80 yards long instead of 100 yards like a regular football field. Scoring in flag football is 6 points for a touchdown and there is no extra point.

Flag football is a safe alternative to tackle football for kids of all ages.

# Flag

Many teams day of the new rules to get you started in playing this fun game.

- 1. There are no kick offs in flag football. Whoever wins the coin toss starts their possession on their own 5-yard line.
- 2. The number of downs may vary but we will play 4 turns to get passed midfield.
- 3. If you succeed in crossing midfield you get another 4 turns to score a touchdown.
- If you do not get passed midfield or do not score a touchdown after 4 downs, then the other team takes over possession of the ball on their own 5-yard line.
- 5. In real flag football if you are within 5 yards of scoring you may not run the ball. You must pass to score.
- 6. A player is down or "tackled" when their flag is removed. The ball starts the next turn at the point where the flag was stolen.
- 7. Players may not hold onto the ball carriers. They must steal the flag without holding.
- 8. A ball is dead once it touches the ground. There are no fumbles in flag football.
- 9. A ball is dead when the ball carriers' elbow, or knee touches the ground.
- 10. A ball is dead if the ball carrier runs out of bounds.
- 11. The play ends when the flag of the ball carrier has been removed.
- 12. Some leagues allow a pass rush, but most teams use a 1 yard behind the line of scrimmage rule.

## Flag Football Vocabulary

Quarterback The person who calls the plays.


The person who stops the defense from getting the Offensive quarterbacks flag. Lineman Defensive The person who tries to run in and steal the flag of the quarterback or player with the ball. Lineman Receiver The person who runs out and catches the passes. Offense The team that has possession of the ball. This is the team that is trying to score a touchdown. The person who hikes or "snaps" the ball to the quarterback Center Defense The team that does not have possession of the ball. This is the team trying to stop the other team from scoring a touchdown. Where the ball is placed at the start of each play. Both teams Line of Scrimmage must be at least 1 yard away at the start of each turn. One turn or play. Teams will get a set number of plays to get Down the ball to the center line or score a touchdown. Professional football is 4 turns to advance 10 yards. Hike Each play starts with a hike. The center hikes it between their knees to the quarterback.


# Flag Football Vocabulary

Huddle	The team gets together to plan the next play
Pass	A ball that is thrown forward usually by the quarterback.
Handoff	When the quarterback hands the ball to a running back or another player.
Complete	A thrown ball that is caught by a player, usually a receiver.
Incomplete	A thrown ball that is not caught by a player, usually a receiver.
Interception	A thrown ball that is caught by the defensive team.
Safety	When the defensive team steals the flag a player in their own endzone. A safety is worth 2 points.
Touchdown	When the offensive team gets into their opponents endzone with the ball. A touchdown is worth 6 points.
Extra Points	There are NO extra points in flag football. In professional football an extra point can be worth 1 or 2 points.
Kick Off	There are NO kickoffs in flag football. Professional football has a kickoff to start the game and after each score.


