



basket using one hand, typically off the backboard








an unguarded shot awarded to a player as a result of a foul, worth one point



JARGON JOUST

when a defensive player gains possession of the ball from an opponent


JARGON JOUST



an offensive strategy where the team quickly moves the ball up the court to score before the defense can set up







when an offensive team loses possession of the ball without taking a shot

JARGON JOUST



violation that occurs when a player takes too many steps without dribbling the ball

JARGON JOUST



a violation of the rules resulting in free throws or possession for the opposing team

technical foul

JARGON JOUST

Crossover

post up

a foul resulting from unsportsmanlike conduct or violation of specific rules

JARGON JOUST

a dribbling move where a player quickly changes the direction of the ball from one hand to the other

JARGON JOUST

an offensive move where a player positions themselves close to the basket to receive a pass and score









an offensive move where a player positions themselves to block the path of a defender, allowing a teammate to get open

JARGON JOUST



a play where a player throws the ball near the basket, and a teammate catches and dunks or lays it in before landing

JARGON JOUST



a shot attempt that completely misses the rim and backboard

JARGON JOUST

zone defense **JARGON JOUST**

buzzer beater



a defensive strategy where players guard specific areas of the court instead of individual opponents

JARGON JOUST

a shot made right before the game clock expires, often at the end of a quarter or the game



JARGON JOUST ANSWERS
